



PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

RIDOMIL GOLD 25G SYSTEMIC GRANULAR FUNGICIDE
PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS
Containing:25 g/kg METALAXYL as its only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Disease	Rate
PARSLEY.	PYTHIUM ROOT ROT & PHYTOPHTHORA ROOT ROT	Apply at a rate of 40kg product per hectare OR 120 g product per 100 m row.

Critical Use Comments:

- Apply dry granules to the soil surface in a 30cm wide band at planting or early seedling stage.
- Rainfall or irrigation is required after application to incorporate into the soil.
- Apply only one application per crop.

Withholding Period:

NOT REQUIRED WHEN USED AS DIRECTED.

Jurisdiction:

QLD ONLY.

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

Other information:

Export of treated produce:

To allow produce from treated plants to be supplied or otherwise made available for human consumption the APVMA has established a Maximum Residue Limit (MRL) for metalaxyl-M in parsley at 0.3mg/kg.

This limit applies only to produce marketed and consumed in Australia. Therefore if treated produce is to be exported due account should be taken of the residue definition and residue limits/import tolerances of importing countries and that any residues must not exceed those requirements of the importing country
